ERNEST K. COCHRAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Once known as the Delta Zeta Scholarship, the Ernest K. Cochran Memorial Scholarship was rededicated after its namesake's death in 2005.

"My husband was always a good supporter of Delta Zeta," said Betty Cochran Page, who is a 50-year member of the service organization. "When he died, (the sorority) received a lot of memorial donations for him."

The fund focuses on students applying to smaller schools. Scholarship is not part of the equation, but participating in school activities is something the group considers important.
